Rees Hall is a period style guesthouse that stands just 250 metres from the seafront. Constructed in 1996, it retains many of the original features of a Victorian hotel that previously stood on the site, including the attractive wrought iron work.

Rees Hall is owned and managed by the University of Portsmouth which prides itself on its high levels of service and customer care. Over the past few years Rees Hall has won awards for the quality of its catering, as well as being voted by readers of the *Group Travel Organiser* magazine as the Best UK University Accommodation.

From its enviable location it is only a short walk along the beach to the D-Day Museum and Southsea Pier, or follow the Millennium Trail to Gunwharf Quays, the Emirates Spinnaker Tower and the Historic Dockyard.

Rees Hall offers 25 double and over 200 single rooms, all of which are en suite, many with sea views. Additional features include a courtyard garden, two guest lounges (one with sea views), a licensed bar and lifts to every floor.

How to find us

Road

Exit the M27 at Junction 12 for Portsmouth West (M275). At the end of the M275 follow signs for the seafront through the city. As you reach the seafront, Rees Hall is immediately on your left. We can provide limited parking for blue badge holders on a first-come, first-served basis. On-road car parking is available outside Rees Hall. Additional car parking is available at the Isle of Wight Hovercraft terminal, located only 200 metres away. For sat nav users, the postcode is PO5 3AP.

Train

Portsmouth is served by direct rail services from London, the south west and the Midlands. The city has two central stations: Portsmouth Harbour and Portsmouth & Southsea. We advise you alight at Portsmouth Harbour. The station is approximately one mile from Rees Hall.
